

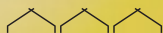

OPEN CALL RESIDENTES

The Department of Culture of the City Council of Boiro, puts out of tender the contest “Residents: Artistic Residences Boiro 2022” -in collaboration with the art gallery “La Doce”-, which aims to encourage creativity and visual artistic creation and contribute to the consolidation and growth of the local artistic sector, by means of a fully equipped space, time and context, where artists will be able to develop their artistic research and production project in optimal conditions.



1. PARTICIPANTS: Any adult artist using contemporary artistic language (painting, sculpture, video art, photography, performance, land art...), who needs a studio to work on a specific artistic project or to start a process of artistic investigation and experimentation in the surroundings of the Boiro can register in this contest. Living in Spain, any other country of the European Union or having a visa in order is also required.

2. AWARD: The winner will receive a €1000 award, subject to tax retention in accordance with current fiscal legislation; fully equipped private rental accommodation (valued at €1000), to be shared among the 3 winners from September 1 to 30, 2022, which will be donated in kind by the City Council of Boiro.

Likewise, the selected residents will have a workspace at the coworking area the gallery La Doce, equipped with furniture, high-speed internet, lockers for personal use, water and natural light. All the space, technical and human resources will be offered for each project, according to the availability and opening hours.

The jury will select 3 artistic projects and another 3 substitutes, in order of their scores, in case any of the winners rejects the awarded prize. The jury may also declare void any of the awards.

Once the decision has been made public, the winners will be notified between August 1 and 15, 2022

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE WINNERS

• From the communication of the concession, the participant must communicate in writing and duly signed the acceptance of the award and send it to residentes@ladoce.net

• Once the prize is accepted, the participation and responsibility agreement must be signed.

• The interested party must claim the prize in cash, sending the claim form and providing bank certificate of ownership of the account and a photocopy of the DNI it could be done online (sede electrónica) or in person.

• In exchange, the artists agree to

- Propose an activity or workshop aimed at the citizens of Boiro, on the subject of research and/or production during their residency

- Give the artwork resulting from their work to be exhibited for a month.

- Attend and present their work at events that may be convened as open-studios or talks

- And donate to the City Council of Boiro one of the pieces produced.

4. JURY AND SELECTION: The jury (or delegated persons) will be composed of:

- Javier Díaz-Guardiola, journalist, curator and head of the art section of ABC Cultural Journal
- María von Touceda, art critic and writer
- Vitor Nieves, curator and Director of Outono Fotográfico and Galicia Photography Award
- María Outeiral, Culture Councilor of the City Council of Boiro
- María Magán, teacher and coordinator of La Doce

This evaluation commission will choose the three projects considered as worthy of the residency, together with the three substitutes, evaluating:

- Artistic and cultural interest of the project.
- Viability to carry out the project.
- Technical viability of the proposal as far as execution is concerned.
- The return activity proposed by the artist.

In addition, those proposals closely connected with the local environment, introducing the experience of the stay in Boiro within the artistic projects of the applicants will be positively assessed.

5. DEADLINE, REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS

- **Deadline:** the participants will send their proposals from 03/15/22 to 06/12/2022 both included.

- **To participate in the contest,** participants must meet the following requirements: Sign up within the above mentioned deadline and provide the following mandatory documents in a single PDF file (maximum 12 pages):

- Registration and commitment form (Anexo I)
- Photocopy of the DNI or passport and, if it was needed, a photocopy of the resident visa.
- Curriculum vitae (maximum one page)
- Personal Artwork Dossier in DIN-A4 format that will include personal data (name and surname, address, birth date, contact telephone number, e-mail and web or blog), statement of the work and images of the work.

• They must also provide a description of the project that will be carried out, either the approach or hypothesis of artistic research, or a specific project.

• Description of the return activity: type of activity, number and age of the people to whom it is addressed, technical needs, etc.

- Motivation letter

- **Place of presentation:** Applications and documentation must be submitted electronically, through the Municipal Electronic System (Sede Electrónica): boiro.sedelectronica.gal (instancia general -tramitación electrónica), or personally in the Registration Office of the City Council of Boiro.

Important: At the online application form, it must be clearly stated that the documents are sent to participate in Residentes: Boiro Artistic Residences 2022. And they must be sent indicating A/A CULTURA (600) - CALL FOR RESIDENTES

Exceptionally, if a participant was unable to submit the registration/documents by the above mentioned vias, they could be sent to the following e-mail address: residentes@ladoce.net, and the person in charge of this program will carry out the registration on his name.

6. IMAGE RIGHTS: Boiro City Council reserves the right to photograph and/or record the participants, as well as the use of images for the promotion and broadcasting of the activity.

7. PUBLICITY OF THE BASES: This bases will be published in the BOP, at the board of the City Council of Boiro, and further dissemination will be made through other means of communication.

8. DISQUALIFICATION OF THE COMPETITION: People who do not meet the criteria and standards established by the organization may be expelled and therefore divested of the prize.

9. RESPONSIBILITY: The City Council of Boiro is not responsible for the moral, physical or material damages that may cause to themselves or to third parties, the participants of this residence

10. ACCEPTANCE OF THE BASES: Participation in this call implies acceptance of these bases
